

RESOLUTION NO. 1196

RESOLUTION OF THE SAN MATEO LOCAL AGENCY FORMATION COMMISSION
OF THE COUNTY OF SAN MATEO
REAFFIRMING EXISTING SPHERE OF INFLUENCE DESIGNATIONS
FOR CITIES AND SPECIAL DISTRICTS IN NORTH SAN MATEO COUNTY

RESOLVED, by the Local Agency Formation Commission of the County of San Mateo (LAFCo), State of California, that:

WHEREAS, on September 16, 2015, this Commission adopted a policy governing the review of adopted spheres of influence in compliance with California Government Code Section 56425; and

WHEREAS, the Executive Officer has reviewed the spheres of influence of cities and special districts in northern areas of San Mateo County and prepared a report, *North County Cities & Special Districts Municipal Service Review and Sphere of Influence Study*, including recommendations on reaffirming spheres of influence in those areas; and

WHEREAS, the Commission considered the Executive Officer's recommendations at regular meetings on July 15, 2015 and September 16, 2015 and at the meetings heard and considered any written and oral testimony and the report of the Executive Officer.

NOW, THEREFORE, IT IS HEREBY DETERMINED AND ORDERED that the Commission, based on the information contained in the report of the Executive Officer and information received and considered during the public hearings and the LAFCo meetings, the spheres of influence adopted for the following agencies are reaffirmed as noted below:

City of Brisbane	City boundary plus the adjacent Guadalupe Valley Quarry and the California Fish and Wildlife lands in Owl and Buckeye Canyons
Guadalupe Valley Municipal Improvement District	Zero
Bayshore Sanitary District	Zero
City of Daly City	City boundary plus Broadmoor Village and Unincorporated Colma
North San Mateo County Sanitation District	Coterminous
Town of Colma	Coterminous
Colma Fire Protection District	Zero
Broadmoor Police Protection District	Zero
City of Pacifica	City boundary plus predominantly open space lands, including portions of the Golden Gate National Recreational Area, the State and County park systems, and protected watersheds
North Coast County Water District	Coterminous with the recommendation that the district be established as a subsidiary of the City of Pacifica




