CSDA Announces Affiliation with San Mateo County Chapter



On November 16, the CSDA Board of Directors voted unanimously to sign an affiliation agreement with the San Mateo County Chapter of the California Special Districts Association.

The San Mateo Chapter is comprised of 22 special districts within San Mateo County and meets quarterly to provide networking opportunities, discuss state and local issues, hear from elected and community leaders, and advance the interests of special districts.

Affiliation with CSDA also gives the Chapter access to trainings, speakers, membership resources and regular updates on legislation and advocacy programs. The new chapter joins three current local CSDA Affiliated Special District Chapters in the Bay Area Network, representing Alameda, Contra Costa and Santa Clara Counties.
